Kurzvorstellung und wirtschaftsethischer Bezug

Tom L. Beauchamp, geboren in Austin, Texas; Abschlüsse in Theologie, Yale University (1966) und Philosophie an der Johns Hopkins University an welcher er 1970 auch promovierte. 1970 wurde er Mitglied der Philosophischen Fakultät der Georgetown University und nahm Mitte der 70'er Jahre einen Ruf an das Kennedy Institute of Ethics an.

Beauchamp legt in seiner Karriere einen großen Schwerpunkt auf angewandte Philosophie. Im Bereich Wirtschaftsethik ist er Autor zahlreicher Veröffentlichungen z.B. „Case Studies in Business, Ethics, and Society“ (bereits 5. Ausgabe). Er ist ebenso Mitherausgeber von „Ethical Theory and Business“ (bereits in 8. Auflage). Aktuell arbeitet er zusammen mit George Brenkert an einem „state of the art“ Lehrbuch im Bereich Wirtschaftsethik mit dem Titel: „Oxford Handbook of Business Ethics“.

2004 erhielt Beauchamp den „Lifetime Achievement Award of the American Society of Bioethics and Humanities (ASBH)“ in Anerkennung seines herausragenden Beitrages und seiner signifikanten Publikationen im Bereich Bioethik und Geisteswissenschaften. 2003 erhielt er den „Georgetown University's Career Recognition Award“ für seine herausragende Lebensleistung. 2011 bekam Tom Beauchamp zusammen mit Ruth Faden den PRIM&R's (Public Responsibility in Research and Medicine) Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence in Research Ethics.

Englisch

Tom L. Beauchamp was born in Austin, Texas. He took graduate degrees in theology from Yale University (1966) and in philosophy from The Johns Hopkins University, where he received his Ph.D. in 1970. He then joined the faculty of the Philosophy Department at Georgetown University in 1970, and in the mid-70s he accepted a joint appointment at Kennedy Institute of Ethics.

Beauchamp has centered much of his career in applied philosophy. In business ethics he is author of „Case Studies in Business, Ethics, and Society“, now in its fifth edition. He is also editor (with two coeditors) of the textbook „Ethical Theory and Business“, now in its 8th edition. In the next 4 months, he and George Brenkert will have published a state of the art book in business ethics entitled „Oxford Handbook of Business Ethics“ - a scholarly work.

In 2004 Beauchamp was given the Lifetime Achievement Award of the American Society of Bioethics and Humanities (ASBH) in recognition of outstanding contributions and significant publications in bioethics and the humanities. In 2003, he was awarded Georgetown University's Career Recognition Award, which is awarded to one faculty member in the university each year for distinguished research across an entire career. In 2011 Tom Beauchamp together with Ruth Faden was awarded

the PRIM&R's (Public Responsibility in Research and Medicine) Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence in Research Ethics.
